This is National Bike month. May 17 is bike to work day. Do you know how to select the correct helmet? You should try the bike helmet on for size before buying it. Don't buy a helmet to grow into. It needs to fit correctly now. The helmet should sit low on your head. The side straps should make a "Y" below your ears. The chin strap should buckle snugly under the chin. Any helmet that has been dropped on concrete or involved in a crash should be replaced. Per National Safe Kids one quarter of a million children are seen in the Emergency Room each year with bicycle related accidents or injuries. Everyone should wear a helmet on each bike ride, but just as important is making sure the helmet fits correctly. Marianne Hickey RN
