DB Athletics Hall of Fame

The Don Bosco Athletic Hall of Fame Class of 2022 was inducted on Saturday, November 26 in the Don Bosco High School gymnasium. Tours were offered beforehand and there was a social at the American Legion in Gilbertville afterwards. Congratulations to the Hall of Fame Class of 2022! GO DONS!!!

Jane Becker - Head softball coach from 1986-2019 with a record of 962-415 and eight state tournament appearances with a high finish of 3rd in 2013. In 33 years at DB, she never had a losing season, and was inducted into the IHGSAU Coaches Hall of Fame in 2018.

Mark Fischels - (1978) Was the first Don Bosco player to earn All-State in baseball where he was a 5time letter winner. Mark was also a two-time All-Conference in basketball and lettered in golf.

1987 & 1988 Boys' Basketball Teams - Coached by Tom Fetter, the 1986-1987 team was the first Don Bosco team to qualify for the Iowa State Tournament as Iowa Cedar Conference Champions with a record of 21-5. Led by honorable mention All-Staters Jason Huff and Mark Weber, the 1987-1988 squad repeated the feat by again winning the Iowa Cedar Conference with a record of 21-4. Jason Huff repeated as Conference MVP and was named 2nd Team All State.

Becky Frost - (1987) Twice All-State in Softball, twice All-Conference in Basketball, National Scholar/Athlete Award as a senior, and was a 4-year starter in softball at Wartburg.

Tom Hogan - (1988) Three-time State place winner including State Champion in 1988. Career record of 100-21-1, he was a three-time All-American and 1993 National Champion at Wartburg. As Head Wrestling Coach at Don Bosco from 2012-2021 he had a Dual Record of 226-48 with 4 Traditional and 3 Dual State Championships. Tom was the Iowa Wrestling Coach of the Year and a National Coach of the Year nominee. He is in the IHSAA, Iowa Wrestling (Cresco), NCAA Division III Wrestling and Wartburg College Halls of Fame.

Daryl Weber - (1991) Three-time State Place winner and two-time State Champion with a career record of 128-19. A three-time All-American and National/Big-10 Champion in 1996. Daryl won the Sunkist Open in 1998 and was runner-up at the US Open. Served as the Head Coach at Christiansburg High School in Virginia from 2007-2015 where they won 9 straight State Championships and had 42 individual state champions. He was the Virginia Wrestling Coach of the Year and a National Coach of the Year Nominee. He has been inducted into the IHSAA, Iowa Wrestling (Cresco), and Dan Gable National Wrestling Halls of Fame.

Class Challenge Update:



Nominations should be mailed to the Athletic Director by September 15th with the award ceremony taking place on the Friday after Thanksgiving. Volunteer of the Year: selected by the PTO with nominations due by December 23rd to Jessica Steils (jess.steils@gmail.com) or Leah Reiter (lschmit2000@yahoo.com). Honorees will be recognized during Mass at Catholic Schools Week. Fine Arts: must be alumni of Don Bosco, former faculty, or persons who have made a significant contribution to the Fine Arts at Don Bosco. Alumni must have graduated ten years prior to induction. Nominations should be emailed to Heidi Rottink at hrottink@boscocatholic.org by November 15th. Honorees will be recognized at either the Spring Musical (for Drama) or the Spring Concert (for Music or Art). Distinguished Alumni Award: the highest honor bestowed on an alumnus/alumna by the Bosco Catholic School System. It recognizes alumni who have reached the pinnacle of their career and have brought credit to themselves and the Bosco Catholic School System through distinguished accomplishments in ALL of the following areas: Business or professional life/Community affairs at local, state or national levels/Support of the advancement and continued excellence of the Bosco Catholic School System.
